A. The property contains 3.66 acres and is located in the Low Density Residential District (R3) and is in the Catamount Planning Area. The hearing was closed on April 19, 2018 - the DRB reopened the hearing to request additional project details.

The proposal is for the expansion of the operations of a pre-existing inert waste management facility. The property is a 59.37-acre lot served by on-site water supply and wastewater disposal, described as SPAN 10191, Tax Map 21, and is located in the Agricultural/Rural Residential District (R5).
