Per-Diem Advanced EMT Employment Opportunity

The Town of Milton Rescue Department is hiring an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) to serve as a crew chief on a per diem basis. This position covers 12-hour shifts on an on-call, prescheduled basis. Starting pay is \$20.00 per hour. This position is not otherwise benefit eligible.

This is a highly responsible leadership position that answers calls for aid and provides medical care to the sick and injured while directing and supervising volunteer rescue members. Additional tasks performed may include:

- Daily ambulance vehicle checks and routine cleaning
- Performing necessary tasks for service billing and various other administrative duties
- Organizing and leading training for individual crews

Knowledge and Skills Required:

- Crew chief and/or driver experience
- Certified at the AEMT level and minimum one year of experience with emergency medical services
- Valid Driver's License
- Ability to make quick, educated decisions for first response. Attention to detail is critical along with the abilities to multi-task, prioritize, and perform tasks with minimal sleep or after being woken up.
- Excellent inter-personnel communication skills and the ability to work and direct volunteer staff
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Must be able to lift 150 pounds (with assistance) on the stretcher or stair chair and carry over rough or uneven terrain, stairs and obstacles on scene. Work is performed in a varying and changing physical environment.
