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## **Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) Phosphorus Control Plan Funding**

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Vermont State Recovery Fund has provided Grant Agreements to assist MS4 Communities with MS4 permit compliance to reduce the adverse impacts to water quality of a discharge or stormwater runoff.

Projects must be preapproved before funding can be obligated and they must reduce levels of Phosphorus entering the waters of the State. The Town of Milton posted a Request for Qualifications in the Fall of 2023 and signed a contract with Krebs & Lansing in February of 2024 to be our Engineer for Design Services for approved projects.

Projects identified and currently in the preliminary design phase include:

Bear Trap Road Stormwater Treatment – Project involves the installation of a proposed infiltration basin to capture stormwater runoff from north side of Bear Trap Road and stormwater runoff entering existing catch basin on south side of Bear Trap Road.

North Road Stormwater Treatment – Project involves the repair and stabilization of existing ditch along North Road and installation of proposed dry swale or sand filter within the existing ditch to provide treatment of the stormwater runoff.

Red Clover Way Gully Restoration – Project involves the repair and restoration of existing stormwater gully and installation of proposed infiltration chambers and pretreatment structure to provide treatment of the stormwater and reduce the amount of runoff entering into the repaired gully.

Sammanikki Circle Gully Restoration - Project involves the repair and restoration of existing stormwater gully and installation of proposed infiltration chambers and pretreatment structure to provide treatment of the stormwater and reduce the amount of runoff entering into the repaired gully.

Chrisemily Lane North Gully Restoration - Project involves the repair and restoration of existing stormwater gully and installation of proposed infiltration chambers and pretreatment structure to provide treatment of the stormwater and reduce the amount of runoff entering into the repaired gully.
